



## NEJM.org INSTITUTIONAL REMOTE ACCESS

Your NEJM.org institution site license subscription now includes the accessibility of remote access. With the addition of this benefit, patrons can access NEJM.org beyond your network institutional IP range – **anytime, anywhere, and from any device.**

### Seamless Experience, Any Device Access

The NEJM.org remote-access feature offers a seamless experience since accounts — rather than devices — are paired. Patrons must sign in to their free personal NEJM.org account while within your institution's IP range, enabling your site license access rights to sync with their personal NEJM.org account automatically for 60 days.

Any device can be used to pair — phone, tablet, laptop, desktop — granting remote access for a period of 60 days to their account, regardless of device. Remote access is automatically reauthenticated and extended for another 60 days every time your patron's sign in to their personal NEJM.org account, from any device, while logged in to your organization's network. Patrons can easily monitor their institutional remote access status from the My Account tab while signed in to NEJM.org. Patrons must be logged in to their account for each session to enable remote access.

### Increased COUNTER-Compliant Usage

The remote access feature allows patrons to take the fullest advantage of NEJM.org information and resources. NEJM.org institutional remote-access automatically tallies in your COUNTER reports.
